GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Items of discussion included:

- a.) Raw Water Supply Currently the raw water supply is 100% Harris Reservoir. At 6:00 am today, June 23, 2020, the Brazos River at Rosharon elevation was 9:09 feet and flowing 2,930 cubic feet per second or 1,315,075 gallons per minute. The Brazos River at Richmond elevation was 9:96 feet and flowing 1,230 cubic feet per second or 552,062.3 gallons per minute. The reservoir capacity on the Brazos River Basin today, June 23, 2020, is 96.7% full or 3,436,977-acre feet. The reservoir capacity of the Brazos River Basin on the morning of May 26, 2020, and the date of last month's board meeting was 97.4% full or 3,502,359-acre feet. At year-to-date the Brazos River Basin was 99.3% full or 3,769,897-acre feet.
- b.) Presentations June 1-15, 2020, BWA and Dow presented numerous presentations on the proposed BWA/Dow Harris Reservoir Expansion Project at city council meetings for each member city. All City Councils approved a resolution to move forward with Phase I supporting the reservoir expansion project. Since meeting with council members Dow has made the decision to fund Phase 1 - Planning and will move forward with SWIFT funding in Phase 2 – Design and Construction. In a collaborated effort Dow and BWA personnel will begin to work on the framework and application for Phase 2.
